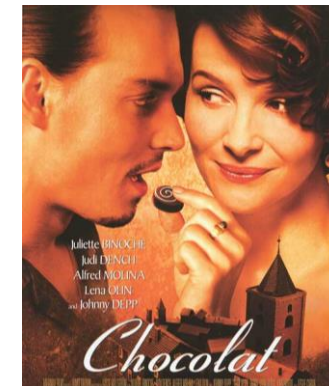


ONE TASTE IS ALL IT TAKES
