WEEKLY ENVIRONMENTAL HINT Use up leftover or un-ripened vegetables. Pumpkin flesh by making soup and adding diced pumpkin to stews and other recipes <https://bit.ly/2d36bjd>. The seeds are lovely roasted with salt, oil and balsamic vinegar (or honey), to make a moreish snack. If you have tomatoes that have not ripened, you can ripen them up by bringing them in and putting them with your bananas in a dark place.
