THE BALFOUR DECLARATION, A HUNDRED YEARS ON

Britain's 'self-inflicted catastrophe' in the Middle East?
Monday 30th October at 7:30pm at Kineton Primary School

This November marks the 100th anniversary of the Balfour Declaration. This promise by the then British government to support a Jewish national home in Palestine paved the way for the creation of the state of Israel in 1948 and what Arab Palestinians remember as the Nakba, 'the disaster' in which Palestine as a country ceased to exist.

One hundred years on to the day on which the War Cabinet made its momentous decision, Christopher Lamb will be presenting a film 'Britain in Palestine, 1917-1948' and discussing the historical context and long-term legacy of the declaration with Mark Levene, a historian of these events.
